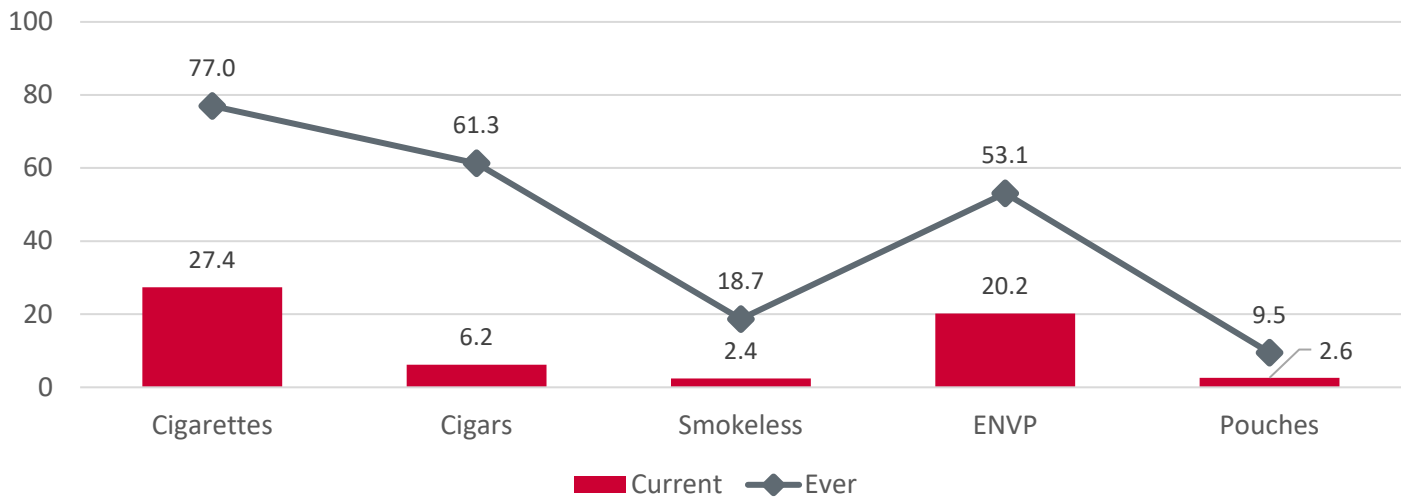


# CRST Data Brief | Rutgers Omnibus Study

This data brief presents ever and current (every day, some days, rarely) use prevalence and top reported brands of cigarettes, cigars, smokeless tobacco, electronic nicotine vapor products, and nicotine pouches among participants of the Rutgers Omnibus Study, Wave 10. The Rutgers Omnibus Study\* is a quarterly online survey of US adults ages 18 to 45 years recruited from Amazon Mechanical Turk (MTurk). Wave 10 was fielded for 10 days in July 2024 and included 1,823 respondents who were 57.9% female and 66.2% non-Hispanic White with an average age of 34.6 years.

Rutgers Omnibus Study, Wave 10, N=1,823



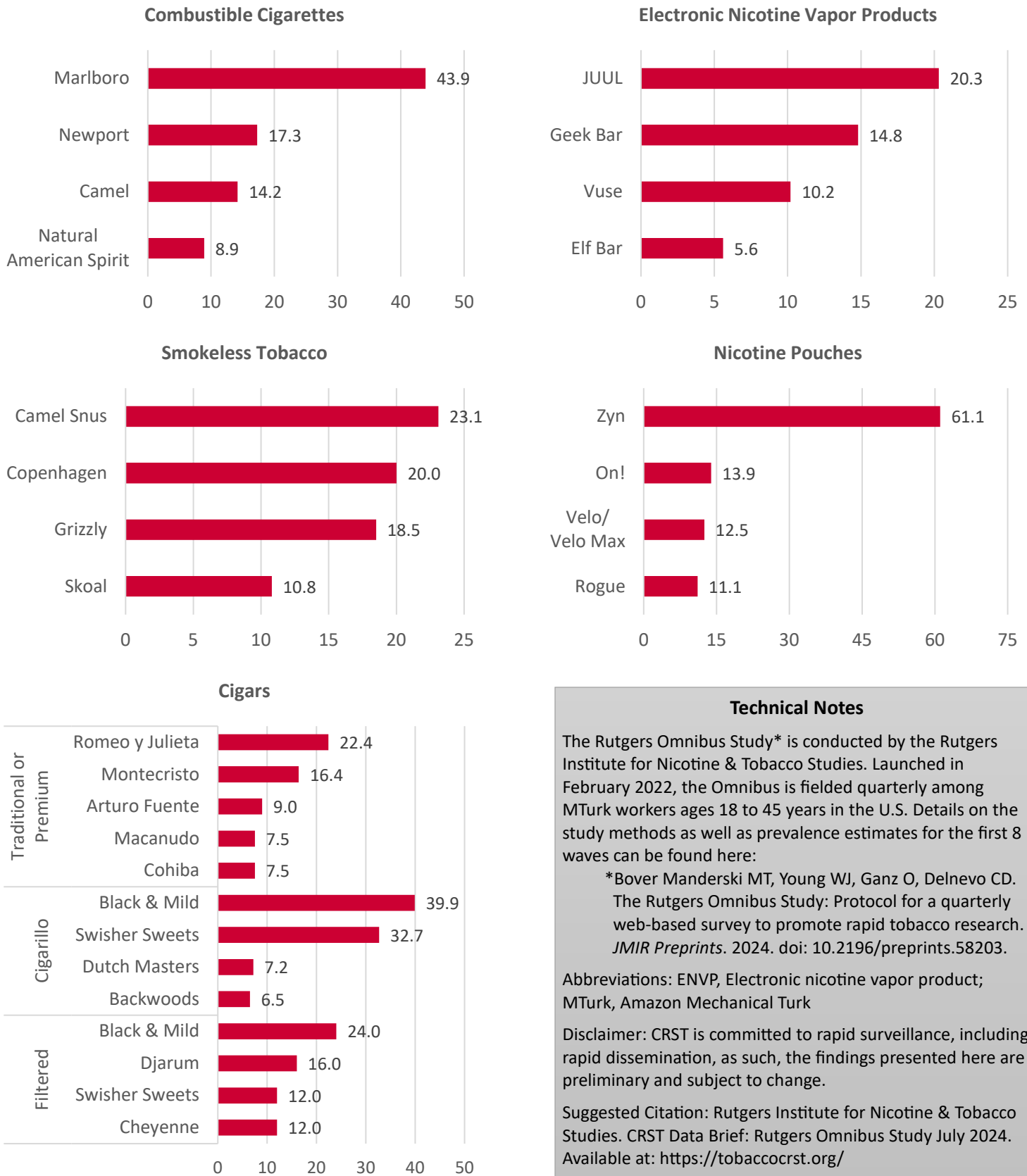

The Rutgers Omnibus Study\* is conducted by the Rutgers Institute for Nicotine & Tobacco Studies.
